

Students will be tested on their knowledge and practical skills. The work assessed will be on their first project in Year 8 called 'Gothic'.

Students' knowledge will be tested during their KO tests taken whilst completing the 'Gothic' project. These will consist of a selection of multiple-choice questions based on key terms they have learnt in Art and covered in first term of Year 8.

Students' practical skills will be assessed on their final 'Clay Gargoyle' outcomes - demonstrating their learning of new clay techniques and processes, materials and influences within their work. Marks will be awarded for the following below:
