**Re: Formal GCSE Examination Series 2025**

You will be aware that the formal examination series for Year 11 students begins on Friday 2nd May. These examinations represent the cumulation of all students' hard work during their secondary school careers, and the results of them will play a huge part in the opportunities that are available to them in post-16 education and beyond.

This pack contains a personalised examination timetable for your child. It also contains a helpdesk timetable where period 0 and period 5 revision sessions are detailed for the first section of the examination window. On 14 May, students will receive their May half term revision schedule, in addition to the timetable that they will follow post half term.

There is also a booklet enclosed which gives an overview of each subject's examinations, including the length and format of each paper as well as a list of revision topics and advice on resources available to support with students' preparation for their exams.

The booklet also includes some advice about wellbeing during the examination period. We recognise how challenging the period can be for young people and advocate the importance of maintaining physical and mental health whilst preparing for exams.
