Introduction

If you feel well enough to engage with your learning whilst not at school, please do so using the **remote learning plan**. The links to the remote learning plan can be found on the website:

You can find the topic you should be learning by working out which week of the half term it is, what you were learning when you were last in school and your knowledge organiser will give you a good indication. UL Curriculum

In the remote learning plan, some subjects will direct you to use the UL Curriculum pupil-facing website.

The link to the UL Curriculum pupil-facing website can be found <u>here</u>. To login, it is your usual school username and password (the same one you use to login to a school computer, Microsoft Office and Show My Homework). Once you have logged in, you will see the screen with the subjects on the left and year groups on the right.

First, you will need to click on the correct subject. You then need to select the correct year and term (shown in the picture on the right). The year is indicated by the first digit in the number given in the Remote Learning Plan e.g. the number 7.08 for the example above (shown in yellow) means year 7.

Once you have selected the year, please click on the link box with the number shown in the remote learning plan e.g. click 7.08 if following the example to the left.



Once you have selected the correct number, you will find individual lessons for that topic . Each lesson will provide you with the resources that you need to use for your learning e.g. videos and questions for you to complete.
