A typical day at GW

- School starts at 8.30am (students should be at line ups at 8:25am) and finishes at 3.00pm each day. We advise students to arrive from 08.10am.
- Breakfast club – 7:45am
- Year group line ups (uniform/equipment checks, GW card)
- 4 period day – 75 min lessons (2-week timetable)
- Tutor time

Attendance

- Making every day count.
- Attendance closely linked to attainment.
- We see attendance like a jigsaw.
- **In case of absence**
 - ✓ Parent/carer to telephone school each morning
 - ✓ Parent/carer to email Year 7 team
 - ✓ Parent/carer to write brief note to explain absence on return to school



SEND

- Information provided by primary schools
- All teachers are teachers of SEND and responsible for the needs in the classroom
- Students start on our EHCP or Monitoring Categories
- Baseline tests and NGRT data will decide if support outside of the classroom needed after the first 6 weeks

Organisation

- SEN Support sessions before and after school
- EHCP students may have bespoke intervention in the day
- Learning Coaches provide intervention support different to typical TA model based on Endowment Foundation research
- Parents of students identified as SEN from primary will receive an invite to a Teams meeting between now and the end of term
