Dear Parents and Carers,

**Re: Glenmoor Uniform**

I am writing to ask for your continued support in helping us maintain the high standards of our school uniform. As you know, our uniform policy is designed not only to foster a sense of belonging and equality among students, but also to prepare them for the expectations of the wider world.

I would like to clarify the following two expectations around Glenmoor students' uniform:

- Glenmoor students should wear a blouse with a 'revere' collar. Students who wish for any reason to wear a shirt and tie instead are expected to speak to their Head of Year and permission will be granted in exceptional circumstances;
- Glenmoor students' skirts should be no shorter than just above the knee and should not be rolled at the waist.

We understand that perhaps there has been a lack of clarity around this, and as such would like to give parents and carers some time to address it – i.e. you may need to purchase skirts to replace those girls have grown out of or a revere-collared blouse.

From **17 November**, we expect all Glenmoor students to be wearing the correct blouse and a skirt of the correct length and with no rolls at the waist. Students who fail to meet these expectations will – in line with other uniform infringements – receive a tick on their negative impressions card and a lunchtime detention. Students who persistently wear their skirt at the incorrect length will be subject to escalated sanctions and will eventually be prohibited from wearing a skirt and given grey trousers to wear instead.

Our expectations extend to when students are representing Glenmoor Academy and wearing their uniform in the community.

Your support is crucial. By working together, we can ensure that all students are treated with respect and that our shared standards are upheld in a way that reflects the values of our school community. We expect students to wear their uniforms correctly and 'with pride' when out in the community as well as on the academy site, so will sanction 'on the gate' if students arrive to school wearing their uniform in a way that does not meet our clear expectations.
